XII. MOTION TO ENTER INTO EXECUTIVE SESSION

- A. Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22(G)(1) to consider the appointment, employment, dismissal, discipline, promotion, demotion, or compensation of a public employee or official, or the investigation of charges or complaints against a public employee, official, licensee, or regulated individual, unless the public employee, official, licensee, or regulated individual requests a public hearing. Except as otherwise provided by law, no public body shall hold an executive session for the discipline of an elected official for conduct related to the performance of the elected official's official duties or for the elected official's removal from office.
- B. Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22(G)(8) To consider confidential information related to the marketing plans, specific business strategy, production techniques, trade secrets, or personal financial statements of an applicant for economic development assistance, or to negotiations with other political subdivisions respecting requests for economic development assistance, provided that both of the following conditions apply:
 - (a) The information is directly related to a request for economic development assistance that is to be provided or administered under any provision of Chapter 715., 725., 1724., or 1728. or sections 701.07, 3735.67 to 3735.70, 5709.40 to 5709.43, 5709.61 to 5709.69, 5709.73 to 5709.75, or 5709.77 to 5709.81 of the Revised Code, or that involves public infrastructure improvements or the extension of utility services that are directly related to an economic development project.
 - (b) A unanimous quorum of the public body determines, by a roll call vote, that the executive session is necessary to protect the interests of the applicant or the possible investment or expenditure of public funds to be made in connection with the economic development project.

If a public body holds an executive session to consider any of the matters listed in divisions (G)(2) to (8) of this section, the motion and vote to hold that executive session shall state which one or more of the approved matters listed in those divisions are to be considered at the executive session.

Motion to enter executive session, which is necessary to protect the possible investment or expenditure of public funds to be made in connection with the economic development project, for the purpose to consult with an attorney regarding negotiations with other political subdivisions respecting requests for economic development assistance and for the purpose to consider the appointment or employment of a public employee or official.

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A POLICY FOR REIMBURSEMENT RATES FOR EXPENSES INCURRED WHILE PERFORMING OFFICIAL DUTIES

The Bethel Township Board of Trustees, Beth	el Township, Miami County, Ohio met in regular session on April 1st,
2025 with the following Trustees being prese	nt: Kama Dick, Julie Reese, and Beth van Haaren.
Trustee	moved for the adoption of the following resolution:

WHEREAS, employees are expected to drive Township fleet vehicles for all business-related travel excepting that which requires an overnight stay; **AND**

WHEREAS, the Trustees reviewed the rates set forth by the Ohio Office of Budget and Management, the General Services Administration (GSA) for Ohio, and the Ohio Office of Budget and Management; **AND**

WHEREAS, the Trustees reviewed the mileage reimbursement rates set forth by the IRS, the General Services Administration (GSA) for Ohio, and the Ohio Office of Budget and Management. **THEREFORE**

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Bethel Township, Miami County that the Trustees, Fiscal Officer, Township Administrator, Director of Planning & Zoning, Fire Officers, and any other Township employee may be reimbursed for actual and necessary traveling and other expenses incurred while attending any gathering, conference, or convention, or while performing official duties, inside or outside this state, if authorized by the Board of Trustees as follows:

SECTION 1. Lodging shall be reimbursed per the Ohio Office of Budget and Management state travel reimbursement guidelines; when nearby lodging cannot be secured within the limits defined by the Ohio Office

of Budget and Management, lodging can be secured at the government employee rate with pre-approval from the Bethel Township Fiscal Officer.

SECTION 2. Meals and incidentals shall be reimbursed per the Ohio Office of Budget and Management state travel reimbursement guidelines.

SECTION 3. Mileage shall be reimbursed per the Ohio Office of Budget and Management state travel reimbursement guidelines; excepting cases with an overnight stay, mileage shall only be reimbursed for driving a personal vehicle with pre-approval from the Bethel Township Fiscal Officer.

SECTION 4. Receipts will be required, except in cases where none is normally provided, such as from a vending machine.

SECTION 5. Bethel Township will not reimburse alcohol expenses.

SECTION 6. This resolution shall be in effect retroactively beginning January 1, 2025.
