WHEREAS, MIMAI COUNTY SANITARY ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT HAS REQUESTED THAT BETHEL TOWNSHIP FORMALLY COMMIT TO FUNDING THE PHONETON WATER PROJECT, ; AND

WHEREAS, THE BETHEL TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES HAVE PREVIOUSLY AGREED TO CONTRIBUTE ONE MILLION (\$1,000,000) TO THE PROJECT IN ORDER TO KEEP ASSESSMENTS TO THE CITIZENS DOWN;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THE BETHEL TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES AGREES TO FUND ONE MILLION DOLLARS (\$1,000,000) TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE PHONETON WATER LINE PROJECT.
