RESOLUTION 17-12-083

A RESOLUTION DISPOSING OF SURPLUS PROPERTY (2006 FORD EXPLORER) AND AUTHORIZING A PUBLIC SALE ACCORDING TO SECTION 505.10 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees (the "Board") has determined that they are the owner of property that is no longer of value and service to Bethel Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board is empowered by Section 505.10 (A)(1) to sell property by public auction, with proper advertisement or public notification if the fair market value of property to be sold is, in the opinion of the board, two thousand five hundred dollars or greater; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Bethel Township, Miami County, Ohio by authority of Chapter 504 and Section 505.10 of the Ohio Revised Code, as follows:

SECTION 1: The Board determines that the 2006 Ford Explorer is surplus property and is no longer of value and service to Bethel Township; and,

SECTION 2: That the board finds the surplus property has a fair market value, in the opinion of the board, equal to or greater than five hundred dollars; and,

SECTION 3: That Section 505.10 of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes the public auction of surplus property with a fair market value of five hundred dollars or greater; and

SECTION 4: That the Township Administrator or designee shall proceed to sell said property in accordance with ORC 505.10(A)(1); and,

SECTION 5: That the Township Administrator is not permitted to accept a bid less than \$500.00.

SECTION 6: That this Board hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code; further

SECTION 7: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
